How Do Christians Explain Evolution?

Very often, it seems as though evolution and religion must be locked in a desperate struggle of life and death -- and for some religious beliefs, perhaps that impression is accurate. However, the fact that some religions and some religious dogmas are not entirely compatible with evolutionary biology does not mean that the same must be true for all religions or religion generally, nor does it mean that evolution and atheism somehow require each other.

The Relationship Between Evolution and Religion

To explain a religious belief in evolutionary or naturalistic terms does not ipso facto invalidate the belief that deity exists. Of course, if one assumes that a belief is attributable to a cognitive faculty that is not aimed at truth, then the underlying mechanisms involved in our appropriating the belief would compromise the warrant of the belief.
