At present, elective cesarean is not recommended for this indication . After giving birth vaginally, 4% of women develop fecal incontinence; after elective cesarean section, this has not yet been observed (e110, e111). Despite this, because of the lack of sufficient studies, preventive elective cesarean is not recommended .

Indications for and Risks of Elective Cesarean Section
